Incentage clients, service partners and software partners.

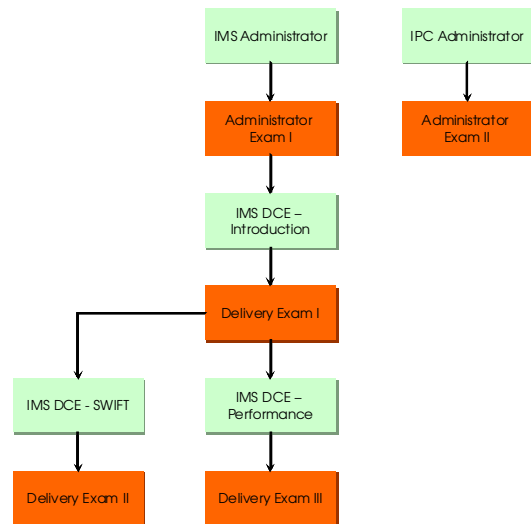
Incentage new hires.

3.1 Audience

System administrators responsible for controlling and supervising an Incentage Middleware Suite (IMS) installation.

3.2 Goals

This track provides knowledge how to:

- install an Incentage primary or backup system
- detect problems in a live environment
- establish and configure connections and supervise flows
- use remote control and extended supervision
- configure and control message reporting and handle message flow exceptions
- do preventive maintenance, testing and troubleshooting
- automate administration tasks
- use the RulesStudio to enter rules to convert simple flat messages
- use the RulesStudio to debug errors in a conversion

- understand the concepts which the IPC is based upon
- detect problems in a live environment
- establish and configure connections
- set up users and roles
- define thresholds, alerts and set up escalation paths
- monitor infrastructure and message flow using the IPC
- understand the basic concepts of gates, sensors and senders

Project leaders who need to evaluate a software solution for an integration project.

5.2 Goals

- enter rules to convert simple flat messages
- use rules to convert complex structured messages
- understand how to convert XML messages with Incentage
- use regular expressions in the Incentage LightParser to simplify your environment
- set up dynamic routing and message replication
- use advanced technologies like caching to extend the message context

- establish an MQSeries connection
- parse and convert SWIFT messages using advanced block conversion rules
- build SWIFT messages from scratch
